## COLLECTION NOTICE

Seymour College (the College) collect/s personal information, including sensitive information, about students, school employees, school Board members and others who interact with the College. The primary purpose of collecting this information is to enable the College to provide services to its students, or others and for marketing/promotional purposes.
