PROGRAM

Riding classes are held once a week from 3.30–6.30pm during term time. Bus transport to and from Kirby Park and pony, helmet and saddle are provided.

Bus leaves to and from Seymour Sports Centre at 3.40pm and returns at 6.30pm. Students' bags are stored securely in the Sports Centre until pick up time.

Please provide an afternoon snack and drink for your child to have upon arrival at Kirby Park. Please ensure your daughter's' medical information on SOCS is up to date, including any known food allergies.

Make up classes are not available except in the case of a Catastrophic Fire Danger rating being declared.

Please inform the Equestrian Coordinator in advance via email at equestrian@seymour.sa.edu.au if you intend to pick up your child from Kirby Park.

All students will be accompanied by a Seymour College staff member or representative and instructed by qualified and experienced coaches.

Students to wear leggings or jodhpurs, PE shirts (no Clan tops), PE rugby top, Australian standard approved riding boots and bring a hat, sunscreen and water bottle. Please make sure all items are clearly named.

Parents have the option of purchasing body protectors which must be correctly fitted and meet current Australian standards.

COST

The program costs **\$1,425 (incl GST) per term**. The term's fee will be added to your Term 1 account.
