OPERATING HOURS

The vacation care program will operate from 8.00am to 6.00pm during school holidays. Your child can be dropped off and picked up any time during these hours.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY (CCS)

Seymour OSHC is an Approved Provider. If you want to claim CCS please make sure you have provided the relevant details on your enrolment form and have completed your Centrelink Child Care Subsidy Assessment. This can be completed through myGov, using your Centrelink online account, or through the Express Plus Centerlink mobile app. If you are unsure of what to do please do not hesitate to contact Demi Saint, OSHC Manager.

CLOTHING

Children are advised to wear comfortable clothing and sports shoes. **Every child must have a named hat, drink bottle and sunscreen every day.** If your child is attending Vacation Care on a swimming or water activity day, please bring **bathers, a rash vest, towel and goggles.**

DAILY FEE

\$60 per child plus any additional activity costs. A late fee of \$50.00 for every 15 minute segment over 6.00pm, starting at 6:01pm, will be applied if necessary.

FEE PAYMENT

Seymour OSHC has partnered with EZIDEBIT to manage all direct debit payments. Direct debit details must be set up on your Xplor account prior to your child attending.

FOOD

Morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and a drink bottle must be brought each day. If children are staying for a long day we do suggest you pack extra snacks.

PROGRAM

Our program is designed for girls and boys aged 5 to 12 years of age. We aim to provide a fun, safe, healthy and educational environment where children can enjoy their school holidays.

STAFF RATIOS

We operate a minimum ratio of 1 staff member to 15 children, with a 1:10 ratio for Preps and a 1:8 ratio for excursions.

COLLECTION NOTICE

Seymour College (the College) collect/s personal information, including sensitive information, about students, school employees, school Board members and others who interact with the College. The primary purpose of collecting this information is to enable the College to provide services to its students, or others and for marketing/promotional purposes. Some of the information collected is to satisfy the College's legal obligations.
