2023 General Excellence Scholarship

The General Excellence Scholarship is awarded to students entering Years 5 to 10 in 2023, who are not currently enrolled at the College and are Australian residents.

Applicants need to exhibit strong capabilities in academics, leadership and/or service, co-curricular and be able to interview confidently. Co-curricular activities can include equestrian, performing arts and sport.

Applications open: Thursday 11 November 2021

Applications close: Thursday 20 January 2022

Eligibility criteria:

- Proven capabilities in academics, leadership and/or service and co-curriculum.
- Open to Australian residents only.

Applicant requirements:

- A letter, in the applicant's own words, stating her reasons for applying for the scholarship and outlining her current and future goals as well as a portfolio showcasing experience in the areas listed in the Eligibility Criteria.
- Copies of the applicant's two latest school reports and NAPLAN results (if applicable).
- A written reference from a Principal, teacher, or coach.

The tuition remission and duration will be at the discretion of the Principal.

Scholarship application is to be emailed to enrolments@seymour.sa.edu.au.

Shortlisted candidates will be required to have an interview with the Principal, as part of the application process.
