Our girls' outstanding commitment to learning and their willingness to activate and develop their strengths, talents and skills, through significant effort across a vast array of academic and co-curricular subjects, is strongly apparent in their remarkable achievements.

In 2015, 103 girls completed the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) at Seymour, and I am delighted to celebrate their achievements of 56 Merits across 15 subjects, 45 of which were awarded to Year 12 students and 11 of which were awarded to Year 11 girls.

In addition, Seymour College was the only school in South Australia to have three students awarded the prestigious Governor of South Australia SACE Commendation.

We believe that Seymour girls are our best recommendation, and the Class of 2015 are certainly advocates for both academic excellence and a commitment to the Seymour spirit.

I congratulate these girls on their immense achievements and outstanding efforts. From excellent academic results to brilliant successes in art, debating, drama, music, sport and a broad array of other co-curricular activities, our girls are inspirational.

As we look to the future, and the introduction of the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program as an additional offering in 2017, we know that it is through the breadth and diversity of our curriculum that every girl has the opportunity to achieve in a program tailored to her passions and interests – assisting her to develop a pathway towards her future goals and passion.

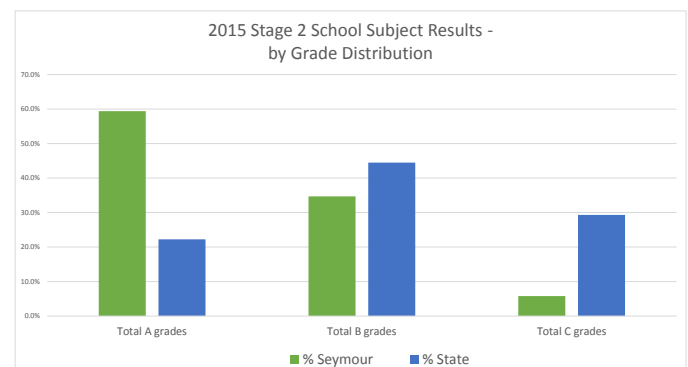
OUR 2015 RESULTS

- The median ATAR achieved was 92.25
- 14 students (14%) were in the top 1% nationally, with an ATAR of 99+
- 23 students (23%) were in the top 2% nationally, with an ATAR of 98+
- 38 students (38%) were in the top 5% nationally, with an ATAR of 95+
- 58 students (57%) were in the top 10% nationally, with an ATAR of 90+

Individual Grades

- 11% of all grades awarded were A+
- 51% of students achieved four or more As
- 25.2% of students achieved an A in every subject studied
- 59.4% of all grades awarded were in the A band
- 94% of all grades awarded were in the A or B band

Dux of the College

On the basis of the SACE results, **Brittany Mashado** was awarded *2015 Dux of the College* with an ATAR of 99.95, with five Subject Merits in 2015 and one in 2014.

Amy Badenoch (five Subject Merits) and **Dhanya Maheswaran** (four Subject Merits) were jointly awarded *Proximae Accessit*, with an ATAR of 99.9. Amy was also awarded *Dux of the Boarding House*.

In addition, **Teagan Romyn** and **Eleanor Thompkins** were awarded three Subject Merits and seven students were awarded two Subject Merits.

Amy Johnson and **Brittany Mashado** were both honoured with an Order of Australia Association Student Citizenship Highly Commended Certificate.

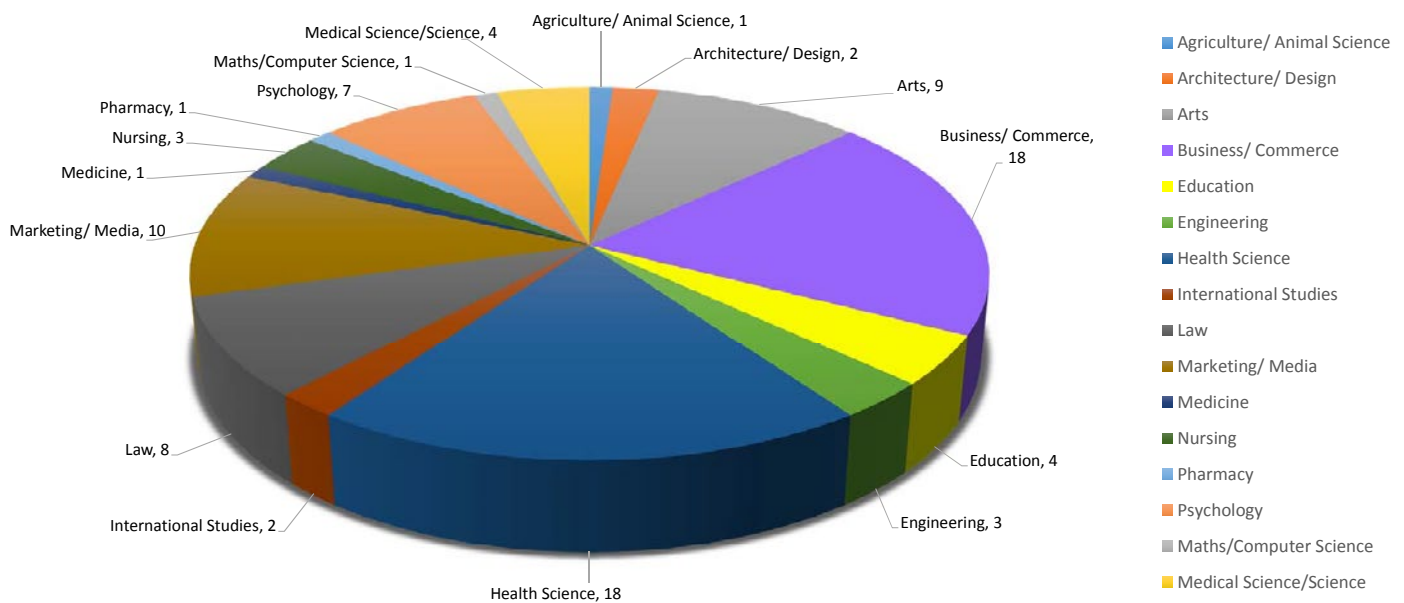
Governor of South Australia SACE Commendations

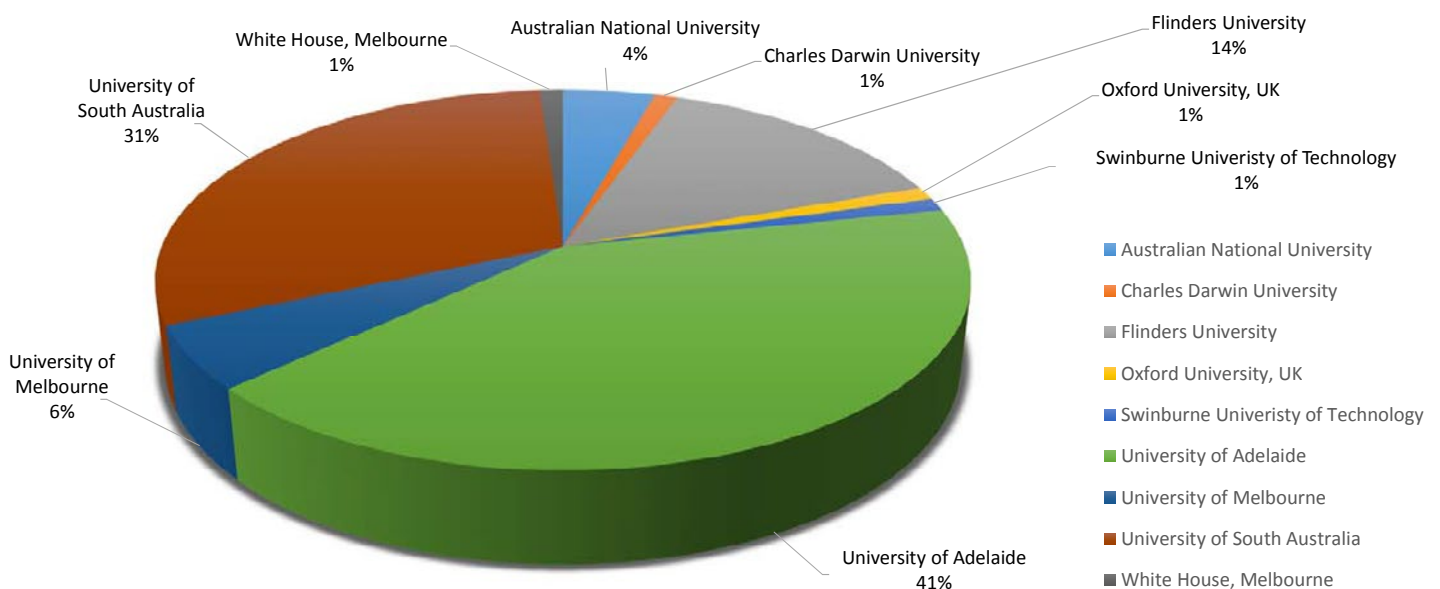
VET in SACE Results
